Mayor Protem Stefl opened the discussion on Ordinance 559- Chapter 41.13 Fireworks amending provisions pertaining to the sale, use, possession and exploding of fireworks within the city limits. Sawyer presented a draft of the ordinance and commented this was discussed briefly with the first fireworks stand peddlers permit issued. Current Code of Ordinance is very vague. Smith commented that he is a licensed pyro technician and has experience with having to meet state laws.
